Speyside

Those visiting Speyside are never more than a stone's throw away from the next distillery. Home to the river Spey and more than 50 whisky distilleries, this is the most saturated whisky production area in Scotland. Styles vary, as in all regions, but historically well-known for light and fruity whiskies and the heavy use of ex-sherry casks by select distilleries.

For Speyside Scotch, we chose to loosely sort the whiskies from fruitier, lighter drams at the top and richer, more wine-y and sherried notes at the bottom.

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Highlands

Stretching from the rugged northern coast to the rolling southern hills, the Highlands are the largest Scotch whisky region. Distilleries are spread across mountains, glens, and lochs. Styles are diverse, ranging from light and floral to rich, malty, and subtly peated whiskies, often with a gentle spice and oak character that reflects the varied landscapes.

For Highland Scotch, we chose to loosely sort the whiskies from more delicate and sweet drams at the top, and more malty, spicy drams at the bottom.

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Lowlands

The southern part of Scotland: the Lowlands. Known for their gentle hills and fertile farmland. Distilleries are few but historically significant. Whiskies from this region tend to be light, floral, and delicate, with subtle fruit and grassy notes, making them approachable and elegant expressions.

For the Lowlands single malt Scotch, we chose to loosely sort the whiskies from floral to fruity as they go down the page.

Campbeltown

Perched on a coastal peninsula in southwestern Scotland, Campbeltown was once the whisky capital of the world. Though only three distilleries remain, each reflects the town's maritime heritage. Whiskies from this region often carry a distinctive coastal character: briny notes, gentle salinity, and hints of sea air. These drams are balanced with full-bodied malt, subtle smoke, and complex flavours shaped by their proximity to the sea.

For the Campbeltown single malt Scotch, we chose to sort the whiskies by proximity to the shore; from farthest to closest.

Islay

Nearly barren, windswept, and surrounded by the Atlantic, Islay - derived from the Gaelic 'Ìle' - is the world's most iconic peated whisky island. Its small number of distilleries are all shaped by the island's coastal environment, with whiskies often carrying bold maritime notes including sea spray, brine, and a smoky, peaty intensity. While styles vary from soft and sweet to heavily peated,

For Islay Scotch, we chose to loosely sort the whiskies by level of peat; with very peaty and smoky drams up top and then mellowing down to unpeated expressions.

Scattered around Scotland's coastline, the Islands, including Mull, Jura, Skye and Orkney, draw their character from the sea. The Gaelic name 'Innis' means 'island', and whiskies here often show maritime notes such as gentle brine, coastal winds and sometimes a subtle peat, ranging from light and floral to rich and malty.

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Blended Scotch

Blended Scotch whisky has long been the most popular style of Scotch around the world. Often combining single malts with single grain whiskies, it was developed in the 19th century to create a smoother, more consistent spirit that appealed to a broad audience. These whiskies often balance light malt sweetness, subtle spice and gentle oak, reflecting a heritage of craftsmanship and innovation that helped make Scotch whisky a global favourite.

For our blended Scotch, we chose to sort the whiskies from the most recent at the top, to the blends that have been around the longest at the bottom.

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United States of America

From our friends across the pond – best known for bourbon – American whiskey is a staple and a favourite across many palettes. Straight bourbon, made from at least 51% corn, aged in new oak barrels and matured for at least two years, offers a balance of sweetness, oak, and spice. Mash bills vary across distilleries, from rye-heavy recipes that produce bold, peppery flavours to wheated versions that are soft, rich, and creamy. This diversity has helped bourbon become one of the most popular and distinctive styles of whisky in the world.

Japanese whisky draws inspiration from Scotland but has developed a character all its own. Distilleries such as Suntory, founded in the 1920s, combine meticulous craftsmanship with a focus on balance and precision. These whiskies are often light, elegant and refined, with delicate fruit, subtle malt, and gentle oak, reflecting both the heritage of Scottish techniques and the artistry of Japanese.
